About the Programme

The Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Programme (BIP) on Addiction and Addiction Prevention aims to provide students with a comprehensive understanding of addiction from medical, psychological, social, and legal perspectives. Through a combination of online lectures and face-to-face activities, participants will explore the causes, types, and consequences of addictive behaviors as well as effective prevention and intervention strategies. The program brings together international students and experts to discuss global and cross-cultural aspects of addiction, visit relevant institutions, and develop practical skills for promoting healthy lifestyles and prevention awareness in society.



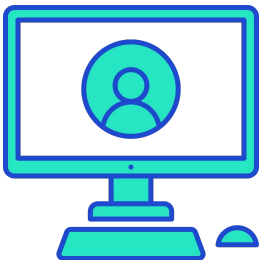

Objectives & Description

The Erasmus+ Blended Intensive Programme (BIP) on Addiction and Addiction Prevention aims to provide participants with an interdisciplinary understanding of addiction by combining theoretical knowledge with practical learning experiences. Through a blended format of online sessions and face-to-face activities, the programme explores different forms of addiction, including tobacco, alcohol, substance use, and behavioral addictions such as technology and gambling. Participants examine the biological, psychological, and social dimensions of addiction while gaining insight into prevention strategies, healthy lifestyle promotion, treatment approaches, and relapse prevention.

The programme also includes workshops, discussions, and institutional visits that enable students to observe real-life practices and learn from professionals working in the field of addiction prevention and treatment. By bringing together international participants, the programme encourages intercultural dialogue, exchange of good practices, and a broader understanding of community-based, healthcare, and legal approaches to addressing addiction in different societies.



Virtual Component

The online phase introduces the academic team, learning goals, and essential concepts.

This preparation ensures that during the face-to-face week, students can focus on applied work, teamwork, and project design within an international learning environment.
