Requirements for the Paper

- ❖ Undergraduate and graduate students from any higher education institution can participate in the conference;
- ❖ The scientific board is authorized to reject applicants with incomplete documentation or author of the incorrectly translated abstract; Confirmation for participation in the conference will be sent to the applicant on the e-mail. After the confirmation of the scientific board, the author of the abstract allowed at the conference should present the full text of the paper;
- ❖ The article can have more than one author (maximum three);
- ❖ The volume of the paper: min. 3pg. – max. 5pg.
- ❖ The article must have at least 4 key words;
- ❖ The abstract and the paper must be presented in compliance with the following parameters:
 - *Font for Georgian version - Sylfaen; for English version - TimesNewRoman;*
 - *Font size: Titles (Title of the paper, applicant's name and surname, name of higher educational institution and learning level (Bachelor; Master), supervisor's name and surname, academic degree and position) - 14 Bold; Main part of paper - 12;*
 - *Line spacing - 1,5;*
 - *Page Marings- 2,5 (top, bottom, left, right)*
